We expect our high standards of appearance to remain. Pupils must not wear inappropriate clothing, make-up, jewellery or change their hair colour. Should a pupil wear inappropriate clothing that is disrespectful in the context of a school day (no crop tops etc.) this may result in them being placed in isolation until a parent/carers can be contacted.

There is no need to buy a new jumper. You could upcycle an old jumper, get crafty or head to your local charity shop to buy a pre-loved festive knit. If you want to get creative and decorate a jumper, the Festive Jumper Day website contains lots of fun craft ideas.

We hope to raise over £1000 for Save the Children. All of the money raised will go towards this wonderful cause, helping the charity to provide essential items such as water purification tablets and midwives' birthing kits to those in need around the world.
